REACh- conformity declaration

As producer and printer of self- adhesive tapes Van de Borne b.v. is in terms of REACh a so called "downstream user. According the Regulation (EC) No. 1907/ 2006 (REACh) our products are "articles" and therefore exempt from registration and/ or not able for registration, as in terms of REACh only "substances" have to be registered. Furthermore, we are not obliged to provide material safety datasheets for our products.

Through article 33 of the REACh- Regulation our suppliers as well as ourselves are bound to inform our customers about appearances of the substances from the SVHC- List (Substances of very high concern) which are above the allowed concentration (percentage by mass of > 0.1%).

We confirm that we have not received any information from our suppliers about the appearance of SVHC- substances in our primary material. Therefore, further statements regarding the absence of these substances are not neccesary and no additional information or confimation will be answered in form of questionnaires which are put at our disposal.

We rely on the statement of our suppliers. Ubiquitary traces of undesired substances cannot be excluded completely. Analytic monitoring of substances in our products are not part of our incoming goods and pre- delivery inspection.

Should a new candidate substance appear in one of the products we supply, we will meet our legal obligations and inform you unsolicited.
