RoHS- Declaration of conformity

The RoHS directive 2011/ 65/ EG of the european Parliament and of the Council dd. June 08, 2011 as well as the relating supplements restrict the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (Restriction of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment). Following substances namely are involved:

Lead (Pb)

Cadmium (Cd)

Hexavalent chromium (CrVI)

Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)

Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)Mercury (Hg)

This directive applies to Electrical and Electronic equipment, wherefore it does not apply to products produced by Van de Borne b.v.

Associated with RoHS is the WEEE- Directive 2012/ 19/ EU of 24.07.2012 (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment), which has the goal to avoid, reduce, reuse as well as recycle old electrical and electronic equipment. Stationary machines and their components are exempted of the EU-guideline 2002/ 96/ EG. This directive is, as well as the RoHS- Directive not applicable tot he products produced by Van de Borne b.v.

Nevertheless, we declare that all our product produced by Van de Borne b.v. comply with RoHS and WEEE- Directive and meet the limiting values, as far as they are effected by these regulations.

We rely on statements of our suppliers. Ubiquitary traces of undescribed substances cannot be excluded completely. Analytic monitoring of substances in our products are not part of our pre-delivery inspection.
